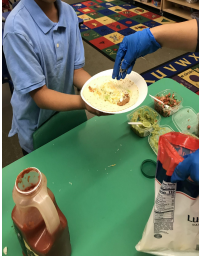


BASE DECEMBER NEWSLETTER

Enjoying Our Burrito Bar!!

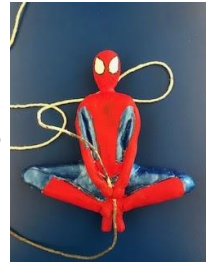
