

WCHS Athletic Clearance/Participation 2024-2025

Greetings Westlake Charter High School families:

Please start or renew your Home Campus account to facilitate your student's registration for the upcoming WCHS athletics season. Before taking part in any team tryouts or official practices, students are required to create or renew their Home Campus account. While sports physical paperwork can be submitted at a later time, it's crucial to have the account established promptly. This process must be completed in advance to ensure eligibility for participation. Athletes must upload their valid sports physicals and insurance information prior to participating in any official team practices.

Sports Packets & Permission to Participate - completed online

- 1. Visit Website: www.Homecampus.com (from any smart phone or computer).
- 2. Click for parents & students in upper right hand corner
- 3. Select "CA"
- 4. Return Users Log into existing account used in previous School Year.
- 5. New Users Create an account. Please register with a valid PARENT/GUARDIAN email address as the username and generate a password.
- 6. Athlete information is saved from year to year and <u>siblings can all be on the same</u> account.
- 7. If you are a new user, verify your email account.
- 8. Choose the **2024-2025** school year in which your athlete will participate. Select "Start Clearance Here" in the upper right hand corner.
- 9. For "School" select "Westlake Charter High School". The site will populate the **2680 Mabry Drive address** to verify.
- 10. Select the sport your student will participate in. <u>If your student is a multi-sport athlete</u>, <u>select "Add Sport" and add the sports they would like to participate in.</u> There is no need to create a student account for each sport.
- 11. Please complete all remaining fields for your student athlete including information, medical history, and signature forms digitally.
- 12. Student ID is "N/A".



Sports Physical & Proof of Insurance - downloaded, completed off-line, and uploaded to Home Campus

- 1. The physical forms and proof of medical insurance forms can be downloaded on the "Physicals" page or received from your coach/WCHS front office.
- 2. Please complete forms and upload a digital copy (image or file) and submit online. NOTE: We only need the medical stamped and physician signed page that states the athlete's name and "Medically eligible to play sports". We do not need any of the supplemental pages.

Sports Physicals

Urgent Care Now is offering FREE sports physicals for all NUSD students on Mondays and Fridays. Additionally, CVS MinuteClinic offers sports physicals for a nominal fee. Your pediatrician can also conduct your sports physical. (Paperwork must include "Medically eligible to play sports". We can not accept a generic Well Child Summary.)

Final Notification of Cleared Status

All of this data will be electronically filed with the school's athletic department for review. Please note - sports physicals will be valid for one <u>calendar year</u>. When the student has been cleared for participation, an email notification will be sent to the account email and to the coach's email.

Maintaining Athletic Eligibility throughout the Season:

Westlake Charter High School maintains that all athletes must obtain the following to be academically eligible for participation:

- an **unweighted 2.0 average (on a 4.0 scale) in the <u>previous</u>** academic grading period (semester) (waved for entering freshman)
- an unweighted 2.0 average (on a 4.0 scale) in the current academic grading period (semester)
- continuous course grades with a letter grades of C or higher and no IE's in the current academic semester.

During the season, Dave Evans (WCHS Athletic Director) will check student-athletes grades weekly and notify parents, students, and coaches of scholastic ineligibility when applicable. Students who are ineligible are not eligible to attend official practices or games/meets with the team. When scholastic eligibility is restored, the AD will notify parents, students, and coaches of eligibility status and the student may resume regular participation.
