



Board Meetings

The Westlake Charter School Board of Directors fosters public engagement during the meeting and encourages public participation, civility and use of courteous language. The Board does not condone the use of profanity, vulgar language, gestures or other inappropriate behavior including personal attacks or threats directed towards any meeting participant.

All meetings of the Board of Directors shall be called, held and conducted in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Act ("Brown Act"), California Government Code Sections 54950, et seq., as said chapter may be modified by subsequent legislation.

"Request to Speak" forms will be made available to members of the public who wish to speak on any agenda item or the general category of "Public Comments." All comments shall be limited to two (2) minutes per person, per item.

If you are participating via the live stream and wish to make a public comment, you may submit your comment, limited to 250 words, to admin@westlakecharter.com. Every effort will be made to read your comment into the record, but some comments may not be read due to time limitations. Comments received after an agenda item will be made part of the record if received prior to the end of the Meeting.

Comments made by the public during Board Meetings may include information that could be inaccurate or misleading. The Board does not endorse or validate the accuracy of public statements made during its meetings.
